We should try and learn as many words as we can, so that we can read and write clearly. We should be able to write some CVC and CCVC words correctly. Letters should be formed correctly with ascenders and descenders written above or below the line where needed. For example: y is a descender (the tail going below the line. k is an ascender (going up to the top line) We should start to say our sentence and then write a sentence that has real meaning, and can be read by others.
